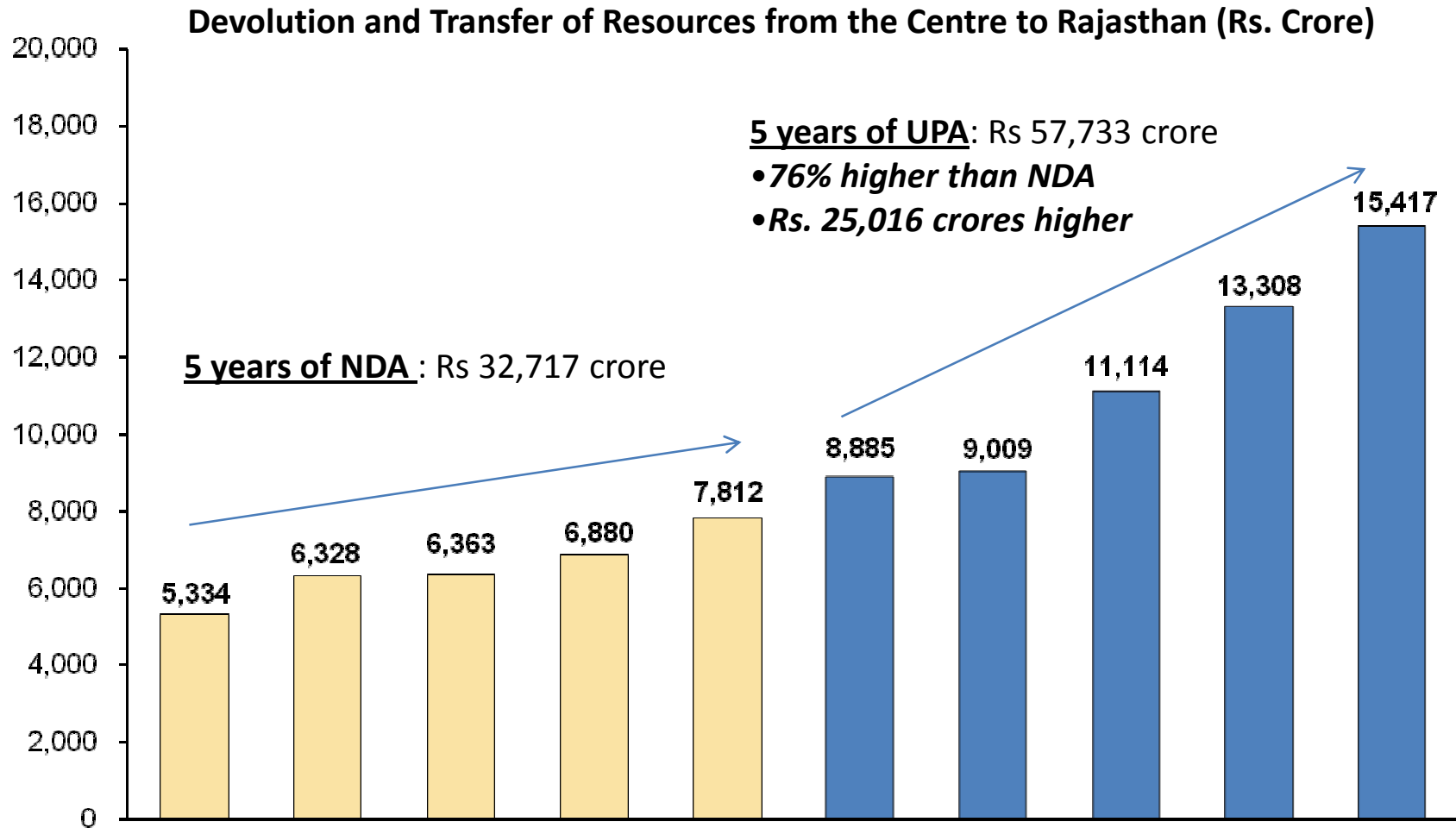
Summary

1. Compared to the NDA, the Congress-led central government has given much higher funds to Rajasthan
 - Congress gave Rs 58,000 crore to Rajasthan over 2004-09
 - This is Rs 25,000 more (76% more) than the NDA government gave Rajasthan
2. Unfortunately, the Vasundhara Raje government failed the people of Rajasthan by failing to use funds given to it by the Centre
3. Instead, the Vasundhara Raje government remained mired in scams and corruption scandals

Only the Congress can provide development for the people of Rajasthan



Compared to the NDA, the Congress-led UPA government increased Central funding to Rajasthan by over Rs 25,000 crore (76% more)



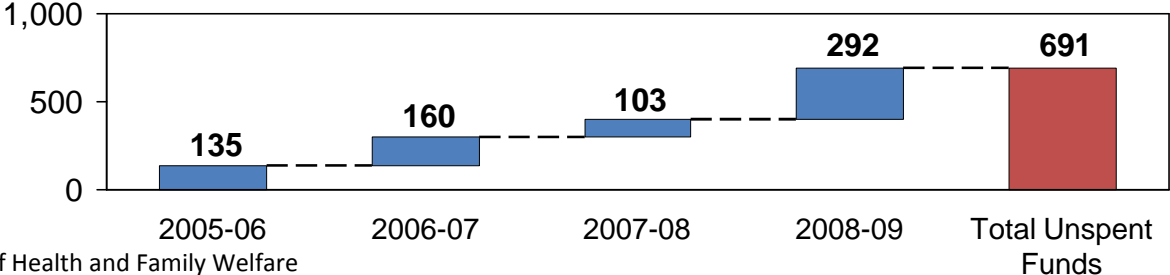

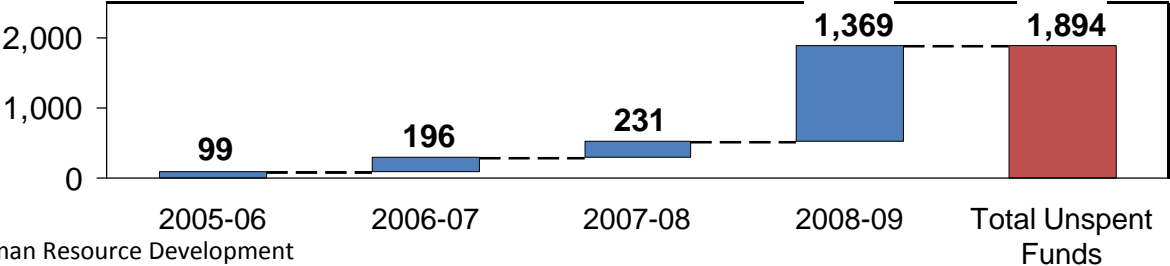
Unspent amount with Rajasthan government out of funds released by the Central government for National Rural Health Mission (Rs. Crore)

EDUCATION

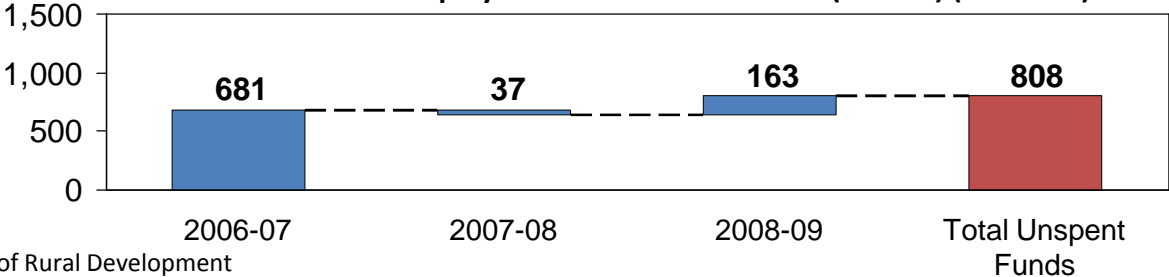
Unspent amount available with Rajasthan government out of funds available for Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (Rs. Crore)
